History and Profile:

Sources: forensic evidence, public records, eyewitness accounts, interviews, and psychological profiles.

Born in Bellevue, Washington (Overlake Hospital).

1973: At 6 years of age, Eisenbrey is found in the woods, severely beaten and traumatized. He doesn't disclose the names of his attackers. According to his mother, he never saw a therapist or spoke to anyone about the incident.

1982: At 15 years of age- Eisenbrey's older brother, David is found murdered in the forest near Carnation. Thomas is ruled out as a suspect. No evidence linking it to him and he had an alibi.

1983: At 16 years of age- Triple murder of some local hunters.

1989: At 22 years of age- Eisenbrey's father disappears. (Summer)

1989-2001: Eisenbrey leaves Carnation after being questioned about his father. His activities are unknown except for forensic evidence linking him to the murder of a girlfriend in 1995 and two hunters in 1998, and eyewitness accounts linking him to the murder of a club owner in 2000.

Note: The following is strictly theoretical.

It is believed that Eisenbrey suffered lasting trauma from the incident when he was 6 years of age. It is likely that he was chased through the woods and then tied up, much like what he does to his victims.

Eisenbrey begins serial murders:

First Victim: Male. Burt Nolan; deceased. (Hunter) Killed approximately 10-20-1983 by Eisenbrey. No evidence linking murder to Eisenbrey at the time. DNA was collected and later matched to Eisenbrey in 2001. Body was found in the forest near Duval. Victim was tied to a tree and tortured prior to his throat being slit with knife.

Second Victim: Male. Kevin Nolan; deceased. (Hunter) Same date. Also tied and tortured prior to death. In addition, Kevin Nolan's body had 17 stab wounds to the torso that were inflicted post mortem and his head was removed and placed on the ground facing his brother, Burt.

Third Victim: Male. Stephen Wilcox; deceased. (Hunter) Same date. Also tied to a tree. Throat was slit. No evidence of torture.

Fourth Victim: Female. Tammie Lancaster; deceased. (Stripper) Killed 3-24-1995 by Eisenbrey. No witnesses. Forensic evidence collected from the victim was matched to Eisenbrey. Victim was strangled.

Fifth Victim: Male. ; deceased. (Canadian hunter) Killed on 10-12-1998 by Eisenbrey in Idaho near British Columbia. Victim was found in woods, hogtied and his throat was slit.

Sixth Victim: Male. ; deceased. (Canadian hunter) Killed on 10-12-1998 by Eisenbrey in Idaho near British Columbia. Victim was tied to a tree and tortured prior to throat being slit.

Seventh Victim: Male. Philippe Devereaux; deceased. (Manager at the club where Roddy worked) Killed on 1-1-2000 by Eisenbrey and Roddy Jenks at a New Year's Eve Party in British Columbia. Victim was duct taped to a post and his throat slit. Several witnesses identified Jenks and Eisenbrey, but they were not apprehended at that time. He was convicted in 2002.

Eighth Victim: Male. Darryl Scanlon; alive. (Detective, SPD) On 12-11-2001 he was attacked while apprehending Eisenbrey. Eisenbrey bit him, tearing his throat open. Scanlon was released from hospital after 17 days.

Ninth Victim: Male. Peter Johansson; deceased. (Special Agent, FBI) On 12-11-2001 he was attacked while apprehending Eisenbrey. He was bitten by Eisenbrey. His throat was torn open and he bled out on the way to the hospital.

Tenth Victim: Male. Julio Garza; deceased. (Prisoner) On 9-8-2003, Eisenbrey's first day at Walla Walla State Penitentiary, Garza was attacked during a confrontation in the yard. His left eye was gouged out and his face and neck bitten. He was dead within minutes.

Eleventh Victim: Male. Wilson Stills; alive. (Guard at Walla Walla State Penitentiary) On 4-18-2008 he handcuffed Eisenbrey and then entered his cell. He suffered severe bite wounds from Eisenbrey before he could be subdued.

Unsolved murders with same profile: 17 hunters, including Eisenbrey's brother.

Missing persons with same profile: 8 hunters, including Eisenbrey's father.

Eisenbrey's execution is scheduled for 9-30-13.
